He then bought a grocery store there in Cache. He attended Cameron University and received his Bachelor of Science degree in 1974. He taught at Kuntz Elementary in Lawton for 10 years. He then taught at Almor West Elementary School in Lawton for the next 11 years.

During the years of 1976 to 1978 Charlie attended night classes through Southwestern State University and from there received his Masters of Administration. He retired from teaching in 1995.

In 1979 he entered into the gospel ministry and retired from his last church in 2009. Charlie and Eve Lee have 4 children, 8 grandchildren, 18 great grandchildren, and 1 great great grandson.

He loves to write and recite poetry be it cowboy poetry or just funny poetry. He is also a master at telling funny stories.
